### PART 3 TRAINING and REQUIREMENTS.

#### THE TEST OF INSTRUCTIONAL ABILITY

This will be one of the strangest things you ever have to undertake and a *lot of fun*. A Senior Examiner for Approved Driving Instructors (SEADI), will play the role of a learner. A 50+ year old playing a 17 year old!

There are 2 phases to the test:

Phase 1: a novice learner of, say up to 6 or 7 lessons. You have to find out what he/she knows, teach something new, put faults right and give feedback and encouragement, with a summary at the end. Of course it's not that you have to teach something in 30 minutes, it's how you go about it.

Phase 2: scenario 1: a Learner of some experience. Put their faults right, correct their knowledge and possibly teach something new.

Scenario 2: a qualified driver who has a few problems with their driving, or has just arrived back in the UK after a long spell abroad or a driver that needs some training for a new job.

Well, we are somewhat UNIQUE with scenario 2, as I have been on the fleet driver register for 24 months and incorporate this work regularly.

So in what way are we UNIQUE. We teach you how to teach not just pass a test. We get you to understand the problem and how to solve the problem, not just repeat what your instructor says, you may be presented with a problem that is new – well if you understand that's not a problem.

You will have to give a 5-8 minute briefing on a new subject – how will you remember everything that's told to you? We record the briefings you give, tell you what's wrong, give out a typical briefing and then supply a CD or DVD for you to practice with. THAT'S UNIQUE! We can even play it back and discuss it in the car. You also get written comments for you to practice against.

Our training for part 3 is 1-2-1 not 2-1 as the large companies do! You will get 30 to 40 hours, not a promise of 40 hours with ½ the time spent in the back with someone else who may not be up to your standards.

40 hours is recommended but it's up to you – you practice - you need less
